And on that note, in reading my devotional, I learned a very important lesson.

The space shuttle **Discovery** was once grounded by woodpeckers! It seems they found the insulating foam on the shuttle's fuel tank irresistible.

The foam is vital to the shuttle's performance, and without it ice forms on the tank when it's filled with super-cold fuel; causing ice to break off during lift off and damaging it.

I found a lesson here in relation to our marriages. Sometimes it's not the big things that damage our marriage, like infidelity, abuse or abandonment- but little things like criticism, lack of respect, and taking each other for granted. This "pecking" away at your relationship keeps it from reaching the heights of happiness God planned for us. Someone wisely observed, *"Before you criticize your spouse's taste, remember, they chose you."* You say, *"But I'm just stating the facts."* **Oswald Chambers** said, *"God never gives us discernment in order that we may criticize one another, but that we may pray for one another."* *Nagging doesn't work; it only tears down your spouse's self-worth and security. People change only when they feel validated and understood. The Bible says: "Love is patient and kind."* Instead of us "pecking," why don't we recall the qualities that attracted us to our spouse build on them and bring out the best in them? If we don't, who will? (Philippians 4:8 NLT) says *"Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise."*

For our marriages to stay healthy and happy, these are some time-tested principles I think we need to remember.

I know I'm going to make an effort to remember this the next time I feel myself "pecking", (and don't say you don't, because I know we all fall into that category at some time or other).

Marriage is God's idea, and it's a good one. I've found out when you marry someone you take on their weaknesses as well as their strengths and you can't expect them to be perfect or try to change them. Marriage is having someone to curl up with when the world seems cold, who's concerned about the children when they are ill, or a warm hand to check your brow when you're not feeling well, (or a back rub when you're tired), or a shoulder to cry on. It's looking into each other's eyes and seeing how much you are loved and appreciated, that you mattered.
